An email to create an account on YouTube or a google(gmail) account to directly login on YouTube.


System Requirements

- If you have an older browser or operating system, you will need the most recent version of Adobe Flash Player.




Upload a recorded video on YouTube






Ready in 24 hours


Step 2: After filling the details, click Next.



Please note that after you click next, YouTube will give you 3 seconds to take a Thumbnail Picture of your video.




Step 3: Click on Go Live.



